Will To Live ½ page	Elie focuses on his father when he begins to lose the will to live. He feels that he must stay alive to help his father. If you were in Elie's situation, what one thing would give you the will to survive? Why do you think so?
Questions	You have been developing open-ended questions to use when interviewing your partner. Write five open-ended questions that you might ask Elie Wiesel about the experiences he describes.
Elie's Father ½ page	Elie talks frequently about how much his father has aged. It seems sometimes that Elie and his father have switched places, with Elie serving as parent and his father acting as the child. Does his father feel the same way? Imagine that you are his father.
