<p><b>Tamed?</b> ½ page</p>	<p>Imagine that you are Kate thinking about Petruchio's insistence that the moon is the sun, and vice versa. How are you feeling about Petruchio's behavior and your own situation? What makes you finally decide to agree that Petruchio is correct? Do you agree with him because you have been broken, or because you remain strong? Have you begun to like Petruchio, or do you despise him? Refer to specific details from the play to help you develop and explain your ideas.</p>
<p><b>Tamer?</b> ½ page</p>	<p>Petruchio married Kate for money. At this point in the play, do you think he has any feelings for his wife? Are they positive or negative? Refer to specific details from the play to help you develop and explain your ideas.</p>
<p><b>Comedy Type</b> ½ page</p>	<p>Classify the play as <b>one</b> of the types of comedy: farce, satire, romantic or black. Explain why you classified it as you did. Refer to interactions from specific scenes to support your ideas. Finally, discuss your decision making process. Was it easy for you to classify the play, or did you have a hard time doing so? If not, how come? If so, why?</p>
