1. accoutrements noun	Equipment, trappings; clothing or equipment. Usually used in plural.
2. doff verb	1. To remove (an article of wear) from the body. 2. To take off (the hat) in greeting or as a sign of respect.
3. ordain verb	To establish or order by appointment, decree, or law.
4. pithy adjective	Concise and to the point. Precisely meaningful; forceful and brief <a pithy comment>.
5. prerogative noun	An exclusive or special right, power, or privilege.
6. surly adjective	1. Irritably gloomy and rude in mood or manner. 2. Menacing or threatening in appearance < <i>surly</i> weather>.
7. irreverent adjective	Lacking proper respect or seriousness.
8. rudiments noun	A basic principle or element or a fundamental skill -- usually used in plural.
9. strife noun	Bitter, sometimes violent conflict or dissension.
10.vex verb	To bring trouble, distress, or agitation to; to irritate or annoy by petty provocations.
